### THE HANDICAP SYSTEM

This system was introduced in 1987 and based on states overall improvement from the previous year. Based on the 'National State Championship' table the States are given a 'handicap' point's start from results obtained the previous year, which added to the current year gives the final result.

New divisions competing in the 'current year' are excluded from results as no starts can be given for the 'previous year'. States not participating in any division in 'current year' will have no points included in 'previous year's' tally to keep scores more accurate.

However, states having teams entered in 'current year' without 'previous year' participation will have the maximum (15) points added into the total to receive their start for the 'current year'.
