Dr. Katherine (Kath) O'Brien is an expert in the operational environment and working practices of sport officials. Kath's research interests cover a range of topics related to operating in high performance sport, but most notably focus upon understanding the qualities that foster the work and development of sport officials.

Aiming to create deeper discussion and research around sport officials, Kath created the Australian Sport Officiating Summit (ASOS) hosted online at University of Queensland (QUT). She is founder and coordinator of the QUT Women in Sport Leadership Conference in partnership with QUT Sport.

Dr. O'Brien was awarded the 2020 Vice Chancellor's Award for Teaching Excellence, **winning** the prestigious David Gardiner 'Teacher of the Year'. Kath teaches post-graduate and undergraduate students in the disciplines of exercise science and sport coaching, as well as teaching health and physical education pre-service teachers about curriculum, pedagogy, and assessment.

She is also a registered HPE teacher and previous international coach for both men's and women's teams in the sport of Touch Football.
