This document traces the History of the Canadian Touch Association and the results it has achieved at F.I.T. sanctioned events. Canada was the fifth member to join FIT a year after the four foundation Members formed the organisation in 1985 and they attended the first F.I.T. World Cup.

Touch Football started as far back as 1958 when Ron Shipp and Frank Bolla decided to round up ten businessmen and play the first documented game of Touch Football. Needless to say the rules were based on American Gridiron.

Dave Nelson from Burlington Ontario took the game in Canada to the next level and was part of the formation of the International Body (F.I.T.) in 1986. Canada hosted a Test series with Australia in 1987 prior to attending the Inaugural World Cup on the Gold Coast in Australia in 1988

Their Membership lapsed in 1991 and hard work by Andrew Clark in 2002 saw them readmitted to the Federation. Unfortunately again their membership lapsed 2006 when Aaron Filby formed the new Body Touch Rugby Canada to try to reinstate the organisation at the international level. Canada hold strong Touch competition in many regions of the country especially in British Columbia, Ontario and Quebec. Canada rejoined the International Body in 2017
