Through the efforts of Mark Brown the Cook Islands were admitted to the International organisation on 9th November 1990 and participated at the World Cup in Auckland the following year.

They again attended the 1995, 1999 and 2011 and 1997 Masters World Cups. finishing no worse than 3rd or 4th and with a sixth place in 1997.

In 2011 they placed a creditable 11th after a long absence from the International scene. They also sent teams to the 2001 and 2005 Youth World Cups

The Auckland Cook Islands Touch Association N.Z was formed to compliment the Head Body in Rarotonga and it was Vae Kavea whose drive got them to the Youth Championships.
