This document traces the History of the Lebanon Touch Football Association and the results it has achieved at F.I.T. sanctioned events. Whilst playing international touch games at some endorsed F.I.T events, some records are sketchy or were not kept and do not form part of the official History for Lebanon.

Jason Stanton (and assisted by Paul Sfier) were the driving forces in the establishment Lebanon Touch Association based in Sydney Australia. He travelled to Lebanon to talk with sporting officials to gain support for the organisation especially for entry into the 1999 World Cup where the Men's 30's won silver, and the Mixed Open won bronze. They also competed in the 2001 and 2005 Youth World Cups

Indeed it was on 5th march 1998 Lebanon became the 19th Member of the Federation of International Touch with Kylie Mazloum the first President and Ahmad Daizli the Vice President.

In 2000, Jason was present at a Sports Development meeting in Beirut, Lebanon. The President of Lebanon and the International Olympic Committee representative were among the members present that discussed the future of Touch Rugby.

Lebanon competed at the 2007 World Cup in South Africa and sent teams to the Youth World Cup in New Zealand in 2001
