This document traces the Results, Statistics, Trys and Records of the **NEW ZEALAND** Touch Association's National Touch League performances from 1997 to date.

It first started after the traditional State v State competition was abandoned in 1997 with the introduction of the NTL (National Touch League) in the Open Divisions. The following year the Age Divisions NTL commenced.

An Elie 8 competition was introduced in 2011 in Men and Women Divisions. This was subsequently replaced in 2019 by the NRL Touch Premiership, an event played before the main NRL game at various venues throughout the year.

In 2013 Mens and Womens Open divisions were replaced with the T-League divisions comprising of youth and open players as the Elite 8 drained the permits of the elite Men and Women players. In 2019 Mens and Womens Open Division were reinstated.
