This document traces the History of the Norfolk Island Touch Football Association and the results it has achieved at F.I.T. sanctioned events.

Whilst playing international touch games at other endorsed F.I.T events, some records are sketchy or were not kept and do not form part of the official History for the tiny Island.

In July 2001 Glenn Robertson applied to the Federation for the Island of Norfolk to become a member of F.I.T. Their purpose was to organise a team for the 2003 World Cup in Japan.

Touch had been played on the island since the early 80's and even the then Chief Minister for the Island, former player Ron Nobbs, endorse their application for International recognition. They became the 24th Member on 19th April 2002

Events came to pass that they could not finance the Japan World Cup so Glenn and his organisers decided to send a Boys 18 team to the Youth World Cup in 2005 with their crowing glory being a 12-2 win over powerhouse South Africa
