Former Australian 7's Rugby player Bruce Frame secured a development role with the Singapore Rugby Union (SRU) in 1995 and as coach of the Wanderers Rugby Club. Wanderers members were active in regular social Touch and supported Bruce in introducing 'Touch' to local schools as a platform for Rugby development; coaching clinics followed and over the ensuing years FIT supported with regular referee courses.

Singapore became the 17th FIT member in 1996 and teams participated at the Touch World Cup in Australia. The Singapore Rugby Union reneged on the agreement with FIT to allow Touch to evolve as an independent sport and blocked efforts by Bryan O'Connor, Maureen Thompson and Anne Goh to establish an independent Touch association with the Singapore Sports Council (SSC).

SSC stipulated that the only option for FIT was to register as a sports service provider company, however, the organisation would not gain any recognition, support or funding.

FIT President approached Wanderer's club member Bryan O'Connor, who registered Touch Singapore Pte Ltd as the recognised SSC and FIT member in the year 2000 and took Touch to another level.

Regular competition commenced, coaches supported teams and referees benefited from progressive pathways lifting the standard of play in line with more established nations.

Bryan's foresight and innovation gained support from the community and saw Singapore become the hub of Touch in Asia.

Touch Singapore held its first affiliated National Championship in 2002. Bryan created the Asian Club Championship with Singapore hosting the inaugural tournament in the same year and then took this event around Asia to support FIT membership growth and regional development of teams and referees.

This was followed by the World Club Championships in 2004, the inaugural Asian All Schools Championship in 2005 and the Asian &

Representative opportunities continued with Singapore teams participating at the Australian National titles and World Cup's in 2001 (Bronze medal M40), 2005, 2009, 2011 (Bronze medal WO and 2015 (Bronze medal WO).

An unaffiliated breakaway group caused significant disruption in 2016 and attempted to oust Touch Singapore as the FIT member and aligned with the SRU. FIT would not recognise this group and much of the community became unaffiliated. Bryan instigated meetings between FIT and a supportive intermediary with the SSC and the government finally agreed to recognise the establishment of an independent Singapore Touch Association.

A 10-member committee was formed. Their efforts were rewarded with their first official Test series in the Women Open division against Japan in June of 2018. Teams attended the Youth World Cup 2018 and World Cup 2019.
