In December 2001 Tarsem Chand Sharma contacted the Federation stating that he had initiated the formation of the Indian Touch Rugby Federation and was now approaching FIT with a request to affiliate with the International Organisation

After much hard work by Tarsem and his team, India became the 26th Member of the Federation on 31st October 2002. Many frustrating efforts were made to obtain coaching and referring resources from FIT, Australia and New Zealand and in the end Singapore Touch under the leadership of Bryan O'Connor finally assisted India with resources in their fledging years

India's first foray into the international scene was at the 2003 World Cup in Japan. The Sars virus and visa problems prevented them from attending, however Tarsem did attend the Federations General Meeting and met the International delegates

Then in 2005 they entered the Youth World Cup in Australia but at the 11th hour had to pull out again because of visa restriction. However in March 2005 India did undertake a successful tour of Singapore and continued to participate in the Asian Championships

In 2007 India conducted the first Junior and fourth Seniors National Championships and were planning to attend the World Cup in South Africa later that year. Visa problems again arose.

After years of frustrating efforts India finally arrived Internationally at the 2018 Youth World Cup held in Malaysia.
