The award is named in honour of Queensland and Australian Touch stalwart Scott Notley. Scott is in TFA's Hall of Fame and was named in the Golden Jubilee Team in 2019. He has represented Queensland from 1987 to 2012 and Australia from 1988 to 2010 securing 61 caps for his country.

The Eggers / Mowles Trophy is awarded to the Champion Affiliate at the Junior State Cups. The award is named in honour of two Queensland Administrators who over many years have worked tirelessly to develop the sport within Queensland, Nationally and Internationally.

Paul Eggers formed the Gold Coast Touch Association in 1974 and became their first Secretary & Treasurer. He was at the formation of the Australian Touch Association in 1978 and was Vice President from 1985 to 1989. In 1979 he formed the Queensland Touch Association and became their first President and remained in that position for 13 years. In 1985 he was elected the inaugural President of the Federation of International Touch. He is a Life Member of both the Queensland and Australian Touch and has the Gold Coast Touch playing fields at Southport named in his honour.

Russell Mowles co-founded the South East Queensland TFA in 1974 being secretary from 1975 to 1981. In 1979 he was the inaugural Secretary of the Queensland Touch Association and took the State to the first National Championships in 1980. In 1985 he became President of QTA until 1996. He moved on to become President of the National Association in 1994 and served for a period of four years. He managed the Australian touring party to the third World Cup in 1995. In 1986 he was awarded Life Membership of QTA and in 2000 an ASM by the Australian Government.

The Carroll / Etherden Trophy is awarded to a small size Affiliate at the Junior State Cups. The award is named in honour of two Queensland Administrators who over many years have worked tirelessly to develop the sport within Queensland, Nationally and Internationally.

Patrick is a Level 3 High Performance Coach and has coached at Club, State and National level. He achieved a Graduate Diploma in Sports Coaching and coached Queensland from 1992 to 1996 as well as the South Qld Sharks in 1997. He was an Australian Assistant Coach at the World Cup in 1995 in Hawaii. He contributed an article on coaching for the book; Coaching Masters Athletes: Advancing Research and Practice in Adult Sport. He became Chairman of the Queensland Touch Association and a Life Member. Also a Life Member of other Associations in the region.

Ron Etherden was a stalwart and long time Administrator of the Rockhampton Touch Association. He was responsible for the creation and establishment of Cyril Connell Fields, the current home of Rocky Touch and responsible for building the clubhouse. He was an innovator and created Touch events to expand the sport. Ron travelled the region for development of the game. He represented Queensland from 1988 to 1995 as a Manager, Assistant Coach and Coach. He managed Australian teams at the 1988 and 1995 World Cups and Test matches in 1988 against Canada and New Zealand.
