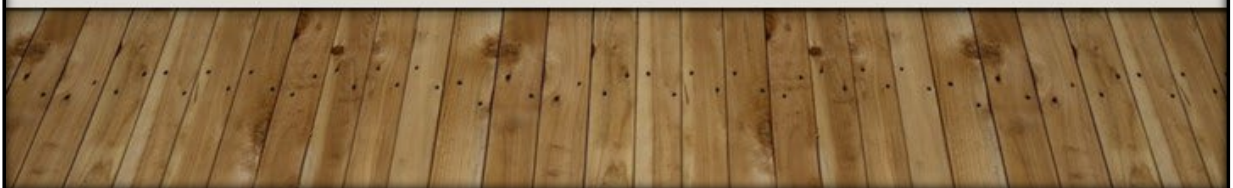
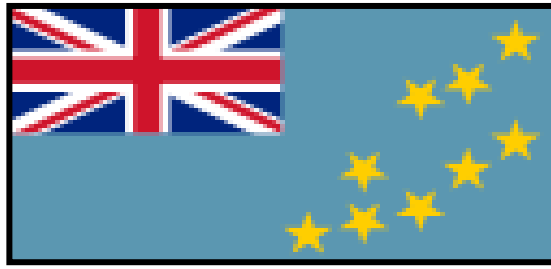




TUVALU

This document traces the History of the Tuvalu Touch Association and the results it has achieved at F.I.T. sanctioned events. Whilst playing international touch games at other endorsed F.I.T events, some records are sketchy or were not kept and do not form part of the official History for Tuvalu .

The tiny Island nation first appeared on the International Touch scene with a Mens Open team at the 2003 South Pacific Games in Fiji. Trevor Tuinanumea starred for the team scoring six recorded touchdowns at the event with the team finishing a very creditable fourth.

They returned four years later to the games held in Samoa but the Mens team faced stiffer opposition and finished seventh. Lasalo Kolokai and Christopher. F Vave were the stars of the team scoring more touchdowns in one game than any other players in the team.

Federation delegates for Tuvalu at the time were Robert Laupula, Trevor Tuinanumea and Davis Lopati but they have since lost contact with F.I.T.
